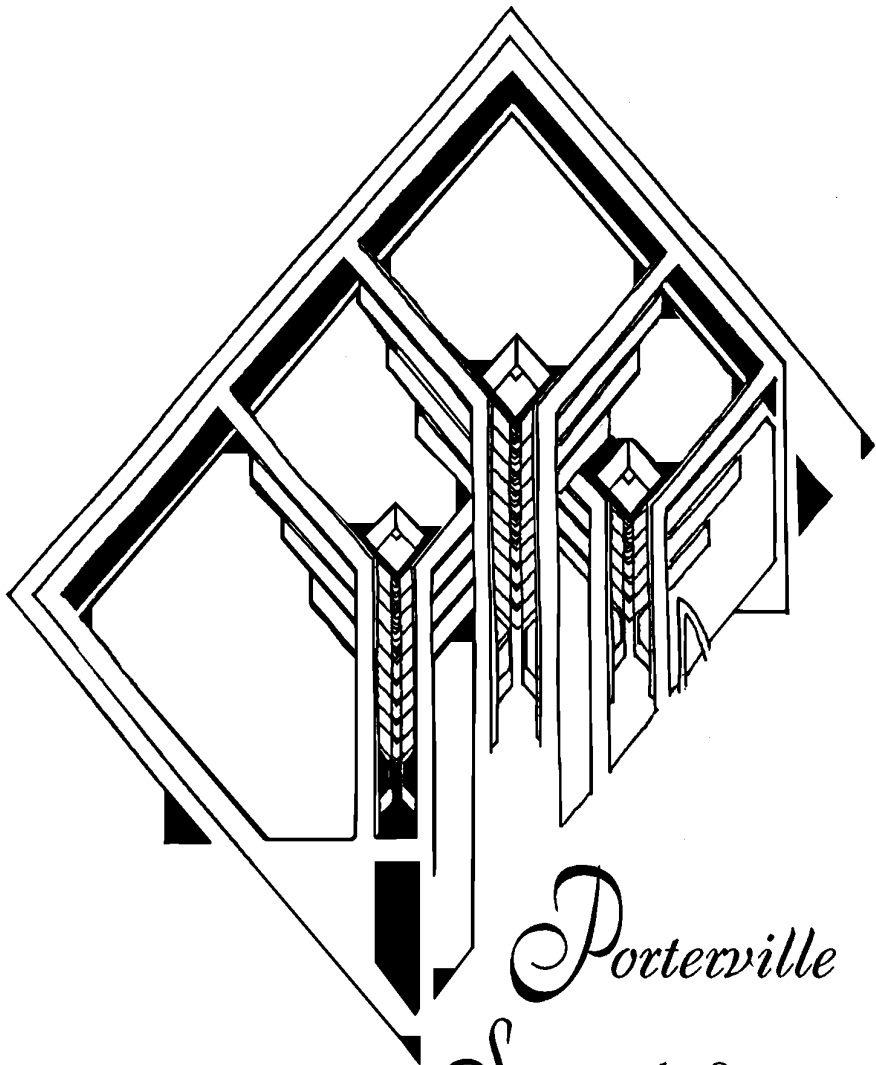

OUR 2015 GENERAL CONFERENCE SESSION : Viewing information is on the church web site.

SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, JULY 3, 2015: Delegates to the 60th Session of the General Conference of Seventh-day Adventist, meeting in San Antonio, Texas, voted to re-elect Ted N. C. Wilson as its president for the quinquennium ending in 2020. When elected as 18-million members Adventist world leader in Atlanta, Georgia, he became the 20th president since the beginning of the church in 1863. Speaking to delegates immediately after his re-election and then more fully at a subsequent press conference, Wilson emphasized three things. "I hope that all of us will fully and completely submit to live with Christ and his righteousness in all things", he stated, seeing that as the core of the three angels messages. He then pointed people towards a renewed faithfulness to God's word and, from that, all aspects of our lives. Finally, he emphasised total member involvement and empowerment in witnessing and mission.
