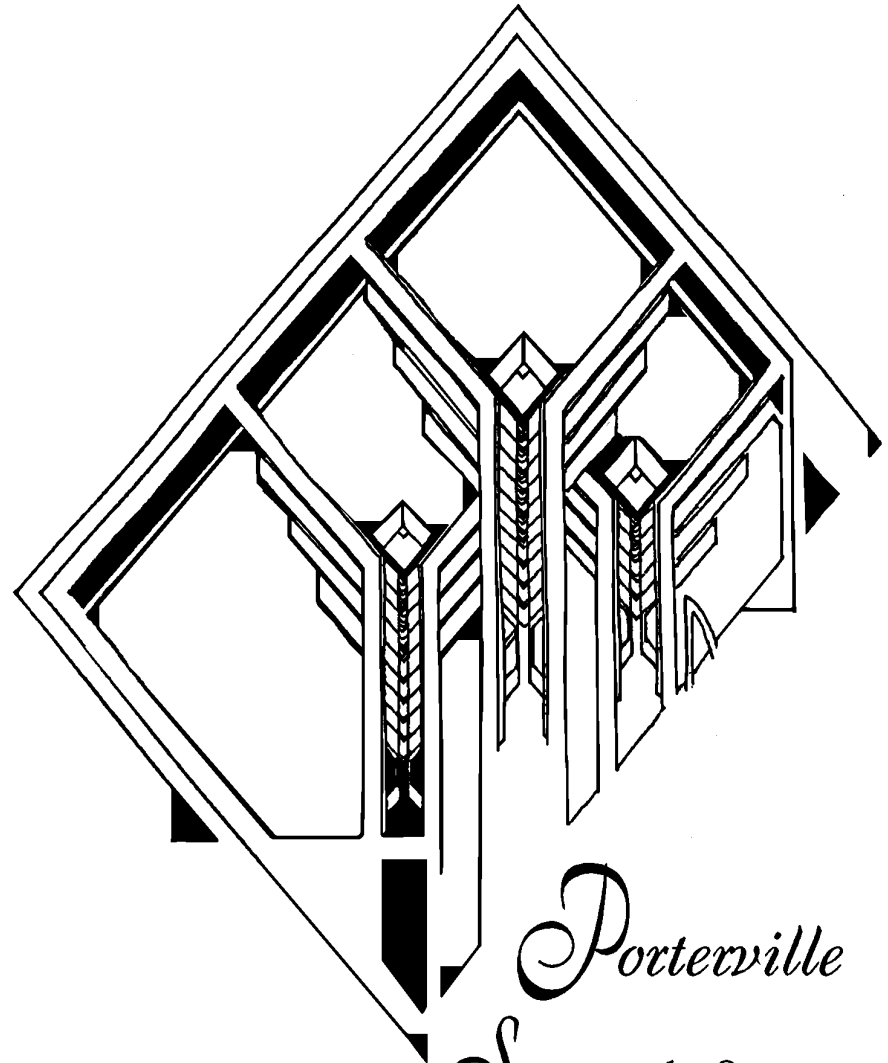

'**HACKSAW RIDGE**' ATTRACTED BEST FOREIGN FILM AWARD and generated a baptism in Poland. Mel Gibson's blockbuster movie on the courage of Adventist WWII medic, Desmond Doss, has been awarded the title of 'Best Foreign Film' at the prestigious Polish award ceremony, *Bestsellery Empik 2017*. The award ceremony on Tuesday, 6 February, recognized the best-selling books, films, CDs, games and magazines across the country. *Hacksaw Ridge* outstripped other cinema hits such as *Rogue One: A Star Wars Story* and *Bridget Jones 3*. The level of satisfaction was at its highest in Krakow where, just the Sabbath prior to the ceremony, Natalia Tatarczuch was baptized as a direct result of watching the film. Natalia had never heard of Seventh-day Adventists but was so inspired by the faith and courage of Doss that she went to see the film twice before searching out the Krakow Adventist church on the internet.
