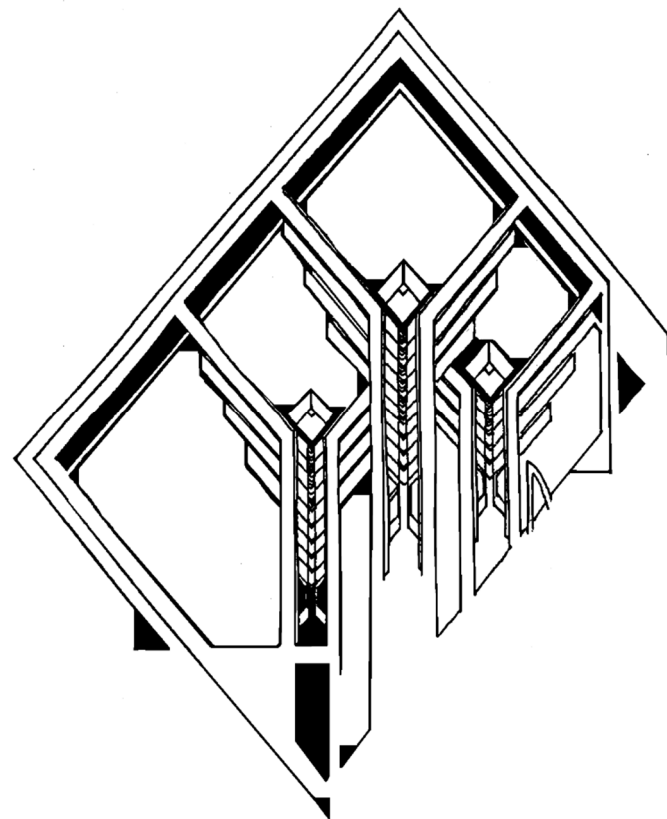

Good News for the Family

Church Family, as many of you will recall, at our church business meeting on January 22, 2022, we discussed using some of our Memorial Gifts' money for needy projects in our community. At our most recent church board meeting on March 14, 2022, the board considered this idea further, and it was decided and voted that we use some of these monies for three projects.

The projects are as follows: first, help the Porterville Spanish S.D.A. Church with church renovation; second, aid Sierra View Jr. Academy with their road project, providing a safe roadway to load and off-load students away from the busy traffic on Ave. 256; and third, provide funds for Maranatha Volunteers International to build a church and provide a community water well in NE India. This church would be dedicated, with a plaque, honoring Isabel Langston, who was one of the primary contributors to the Memorial Gifts fund.
